Nancy goes home

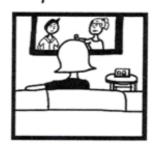


Maddie feels very ill and has to go to sleep.

doing something fun with only minor repercussions but the full effects of her exertion hit her like a ton of bricks 24-48 hours after meeting Nancy.

People with ME suffer from what is called Post Exertional Malaise (PEM)
PEM is a worsening of symptoms

that kicks in 24-48 hours after exertion.

It can last days, weeks or be the trigger for a relapse or deterioration.

It doesn't just make you feel 'a bit worse',

It makes tasks you can normally do feel like wading through treacle with the flu and a hangover.
